Student Code of Conduct



As representatives of Magna Vitae at the International Peoples College (IPC), all students are expected to uphold standards of conduct that promote learning, respect and personal integrity.

The following code of conduct outlines the expectations for student behaviour at all times:

• **Academic Integrity:**

- All academic work must be the result of the student's own effort.
- Plagiarism, cheating, fabrication, and other forms of academic dishonesty are not allowed.
- Respectful Behaviour:
 - Students shall treat all members of the college community with respect, courtesy and professionalism.
 - Discrimination, harassment, intimidation, and bullying based on race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, disability, or any other characteristic are strictly prohibited.
 - Disruptive behaviour that interferes with the rights of others to learn and participate in academic activities will not be tolerated.

• **Alcohol and Drugs:**

- The possession, use, distribution, or sale of alcohol and illegal drugs on campus or at college-sponsored events is prohibited.
- Students of legal drinking age must consume alcohol responsibly and in accordance with college policies and applicable laws.

• **Residential Life:**

- Students living on campus housing must abide by the rules and regulations outlined in the Residential Life Handbook.
- Quiet hours, guest policies, cleanliness standards, and other guidelines must be respected to maintain a positive living environment for all residents.

• **Safety and Security:**

- Students shall comply with all safety protocols and procedures designed to protect the well-being of the college community.
- Threats, violence, possession of weapons, or any behaviour that poses a risk to the safety of others will result in immediate disciplinary action.
