

# Safe Swimming Policy

## at Magna Vitae

### Swimming pool users please adhere to the Safe Swimming Policy:

- The staff may, at their sole discretion, refuse admission if they believe that the safety of swimming pool users is compromised.
- Children may, at times, be asked to demonstrate their swimming competency.
- TO swim in the deep end of the swimming pool, you must be able to comfortably swim 50 metres (2 lengths of the pool)
- All non-swimmers should wear approved buoyancy aids.
- Please shower and use the toilet before entering the pool. This helps to reduce the amount of chemicals that we need to add to the water, reducing costs and the impact on the environment.
- All swimming pool users must listen to the advice of the lifeguards on duty. Pool rules which are displayed around poolside are in place for your own safety and that of others.
- Cut off clothing is not acceptable as swimwear. Acceptable swimwear includes swimming costumes, trunks and swim shorts. If you have any queries, please ask one of our staff before entering the poolside.



### Children Under 8 Years Old:

- Children under the age of 8 must be supervised at all times in the pool water by a responsible adult, at a ratio of one adult to two children under 8 years of age (1:2).
- If one or more of the children holds their MV award, the maximum child supervision ratio can be increased to one responsible adult to three children under 8 years of age (1:3).
- An adult is a responsible person aged 16 years and over.
- All children under 8 must be accompanied by an adult at all times within the complex.

### Your Belongings:

- Please remove footwear before entering the changing village.
- Ensure that you lock any personal belongings away in the lockers provided.
- Please note: Any belongings found unattended in changing cubicles will be considered lost property and removed.
- Our lockers accept £1 coins or trolley tokens (which is returned when you collect your belongings).

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
